All staff are police checked for their suitability to work with children.

There is always a trained first aider available [but rarely needed!]

The premises and equipment have passed rigorous inspection by Officers of Hertfordshire County Council.

About The Club

Early Birds aims to provide a happy and safe environment for children before school.

Based in the dining room of the Junior school, Early Birds Breakfast Club is open Monday to Friday during term time only. The club is open to children from 5-11 years. Please note children are not accepted in the first term of reception.

The purpose of the club is to provide quality out of school care, to meet the needs of the working parents looking for alternative activities and play opportunities for their children.



Operating times and charges: **

7.45 - 8.45	£4.50
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Breakfast is provided at 8.15am and will usually consist of cereal, fruit, yogurts and toast.

** For children attending the club five days a week, the charge is £20.

** A 10% discount is given for siblings.

** The Club will not charge for children unable to attend through sickness, provided that notice is given to the Club before 7.45am on that day, otherwise normal charges will apply.

Bookings are made in advance by contacting the Club manager.

When places are limited; children will be admitted in the following order of preference:

- Siblings
- Children who will attend five days per week
- Otherwise in chronological order of first application
