

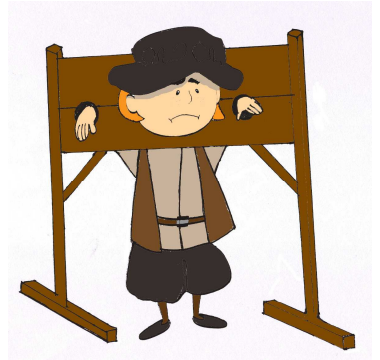


'Mud, Sweat and Beer' Everyday Life in Tudor Times An exhibition at Hertford Museum 2nd April—3rd September 2011
