Sun Postal Sports are delighted to have secured funding through the Active Watford Partnership to deliver up to 10 'free' drop in disability football sessions for children and young people aged 10-19 every Saturday at Sun Postal Sports and Social Club.

The start date is Saturday February 6th at 10.30am. We may during the project offer some midweek sessions however this is still to be confirmed. The sessions will be delivered by Qualified, CRB checked coaches, with each session running for approximately 60 minutes. The finale of the project will be to participate in a day's football session run by the Herts FA against other disability teams. Our overarching aim is to establish a team on a permanent basis and to compete on Saturday 27th March.

Sun Postal Sports & Social Club have identified that they are not providing opportunities for children and young people with disabilities to participate in football and are keen to redress this.

Leading the project on our behalf is George Akhtar of 1st Touch Football, an FA qualified level 3 (Uefa B) licensed Coach, and he is keen to engage as many children and young people as possible to support the project. George has experience with dealing with children of special needs, currently working at Breakspeare School in Abbots Langley. We do have a changing area for boys and girls with shower facilities and a grass surface pitch as well as an indoor area.

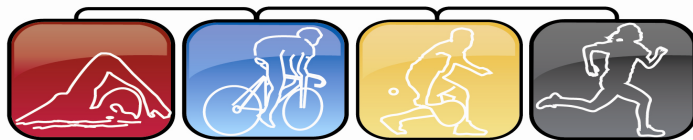
We sincerely hope that you will find the project an exciting one and would like your child to participate. Due to demand a booking system will operate therefore please contact George directly to book your child's place.
